

## Chapter 31 -- City Historian

31.010.                   Establishing the office of city historian; duties. The office of city historian is hereby established. The city historian shall be responsible to the Board of Aldermen to collect, keep, and maintain any and all documents, articles, chattels, or other things relating to the City of Holts Summit which the Mayor, city historian, or Board of Aldermen may, in their sole discretion, deem of historical significance with respect to the City of Holts Summit, Missouri.

31.020.                   City historian; no compensation; expenses paid. The city historian shall serve without compensation for his services to the City of Holts Summit. The city historian shall be reimbursed for any expenses incurred by him in the performance of his duties, provided that said expenses are reasonable and are approved by the Board of Aldermen before payment.

31.030.                   How appointed; term; approval by Board. The Mayor shall, with approval by resolution of the Board of Aldermen, appoint the city historian to serve a term concurrent with said Mayor and thereafter until such time as a newly elected Mayor shall appoint the city historian's successor. Should the office of city historian be vacated for any reason, the Mayor then in office shall, with the approval of the Board of Aldermen, appoint a city historian to serve until a newly elected Mayor shall appoint a successor.
